



Balancing Floof Dragon



Download the file and save it to your computer. You can then print it as many times as you like!



Print the file on card

OR



Print onto paper and glue onto card.



Carefully cut out the Floof Dragon.



Cellotape a coin (I used a 1p coin/one pence piece) to the back of the Floof Dragon's tail. It should be right at the bottom of the tail where it curls around.



With the coin in place, the Floof Dragon's centre of gravity will be in line with its feet. This will mean your Floof Dragon should now balance when you sit it on your finger, on the edge of a table or on other objects!
